As well as world renowned James Cook University (JCU), the city is also home to CQ University Cairns, the Australian Institute of Tropical Health and Medicine (AITHM) and the Cairns Clinical School. Between these institutions, Cairns has established an enviable reputation for providing first class tertiary education in health and life sciences, tropical health, medical, teaching, creative and performing arts, to name just a few.

James Cook University is consistently ranked as one of the top universities in the world, delivering ground-breaking, internationally recognised research and high-quality educational programs that make a difference to people here in the Tropics, and beyond.

The Cairns Clinical School situated in Cairns city is linked to James Cook University and is a study destination for medical students in their fourth, fifth or sixth year of study.

#### **The Daintree Observatory**

The region is also home to the Daintree Observatory, a completely off-grid facility which is available to all scientists, post-graduates, undergraduates and year 11 and 12 students. The Daintree Rainforest is the oldest continually surviving rainforest in the world. It has the highest biodiversity of any ecosystem in Australia with unique biota, including numerous living fossils. A visit to the Daintree Rainforest Observatory is a unique experience, where academics and students can immerse themselves in the wonders of the largest area of tropical rainforest in Australia.

## **Teaching in Remote Areas**

With an area as vast as Tropical North Queensland, the educational needs of those in remote communities often require different approaches than typically taken in bigger cities. Education may not be as valued in communities, with Indigenous adolescents not fully engaged. Dr Miriam Ham has devoted much of her work to understanding and developing alternative learning opportunities to reach developmental goals. This achieves better educational outcomes so students can reach their full potential.
